The Prussian Parliament, which was designed by Friedrich Schulze and completed in 1899, has a very colourful history. Bringing back this building after its disfiguration by the Nazis and the war from its shadowy past in East Germany and making it into a modern parliamentary building was not an everyday task. It very soon became clear that its clear and extremely functional structure would

also meet today's standards. The idea of maintaining everything that functioned properly, regardless of the period it dated from, also led to an extremely economical design. But what is even more important: we soon learned to regard the building as a document of German history, which had to be preserved in order to make history visible.
